The major areas of MDLC's work are listed below. **Mark 1, 2 or 3 boxes** that you think should be given top priority. **Use the blank box** if you want to add other priorities, suggestions or comments.

- Abuse & Neglect** Physical abuse, sexual assault, neglect of health care, financial exploitation, and the improper use of seclusion, restraints or psychotropic medications.
- Self-Determination** Decision-making rights, civil rights, and voluntary treatment and services.
- Community-Based Services & Health Care** Access to: services needed to live as independently as possible, health care, assistive technology, and appropriate housing choices.
- Accessibility & Discrimination** Access to: public places and services, housing, transportation, and voting equipment.
- Education of Students with Disabilities** Use of aversive practices or inappropriate discipline, exclusion of students from day care, pre-school or K-12 classes for conduct related to their disabilities, and special education and services are needed to make school progress.
- Employment** Getting help from Rehabilitation Services and assisting Social Security Beneficiaries with disabilities to obtain and maintain employment.
